Galilee as we may remember, is the place where Jesus started his ministry that we often call the 'Galilean Ministry'. I am sure Jesus intentionally chose to see his disciples the first time after his resurrection in the place where He and his disciples started his ministry as his way of reaffirming to them to continue the ministry that Jesus started.

Go and tell has become a resurrection charge or mission for the three women, Mary Magdalene, Mary, the mother of James and Salome to tell the rest of Jesus' disciples about the news of the risen Christ. Yes, initially they said nothing to anyone for terror and excitement had seized them. But we know that these three courageous women must have told people about that good news or otherwise, we would not celebrate Easter.

The work of Easter for us has just begun. The good news of Easter is a beginning of the good news. We are called to go and tell the good news of Jesus Christ in our words and deeds. Let not fear but excitement fill our hearts as we go and tell the good news of Jesus trusting that we are not alone. Because he lives, we will live also and because he lives we may face our tomorrow because he is there waiting for us.
